Bullying Report

R.C. 3313.66 defines harassment, intimidation, or bullying as intentional written, verbal, or physical acts that a student has exhibited toward another particular student or group of students more than once and the behavior both:

- 1. Causes mental or physical harm to the other student or group of students; and
- 2. Is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other students or students

Ohio law requires school districts to provide a written summary of reported incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying, and to post the report on the school district's website. Accordingly, the Put-in-Bay Local School District reports that it received the following number of alleged incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying during the 2023-2023 school year.
