

Bullying Report

R.C. 3313.66 defines harassment, intimidation, or bullying as intentional written, verbal, or physical acts that a student has exhibited toward another particular student or group of students more than once and the behavior both:

1. Causes mental or physical harm to the other student or group of students; and
2. Is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other students or students

Ohio law requires school districts to provide a written summary of reported incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying, and to post the report on the school district's website. Accordingly, the Put-in-Bay Local School District reports that it received the following number of alleged incidents of harassment, intimidation, and bullying during the 2022-2023 school year.
